## RESOLUTION NO. 01-2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE DALTON WATER ASSOCIATION, INC. FURTHER ESTABLISHING CROSS-CONNECTION REGULATIONS

At a regular meeting of the Board of Directions of the Dalton Water Association, Inc., on February 11, 2002, the following Resolution was voted upon and passed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Dalton Water Association, Inc., Kootenai County, Idaho as follows:

WHEREAS, a Cross Connection Control Plan was adopted by the Dalton Water Association, Inc., as Resolution No. 01-2001, and

WHEREAS, further controls and prevention assemblies are, in the judgment of the Board and Water Master, necessary to avoid immediate and dangerous hazards to health,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered that no later than October 31, 2002, all commercial users served by Dalton Water Association, Inc., having water service connections shall install a BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY.


The installation of the BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY shall be as provided in Resolution No. 01-2001, and upon installation the member shall provide written proof to Dalton Water Association, Inc., by an American Water Works Association certified tester, or equal, that the materials and installation comply with all State of Idaho, Division of Environmental Quality standards and the standards of the above referred to Resolution 01-2001.

In the event the member fails to comply with this Resolution by October 31, 2002, Dalton Water Association, Inc., shall have the right to terminate water services to the premises or take whatever other action allowed by the Association's Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, or Idaho law.


